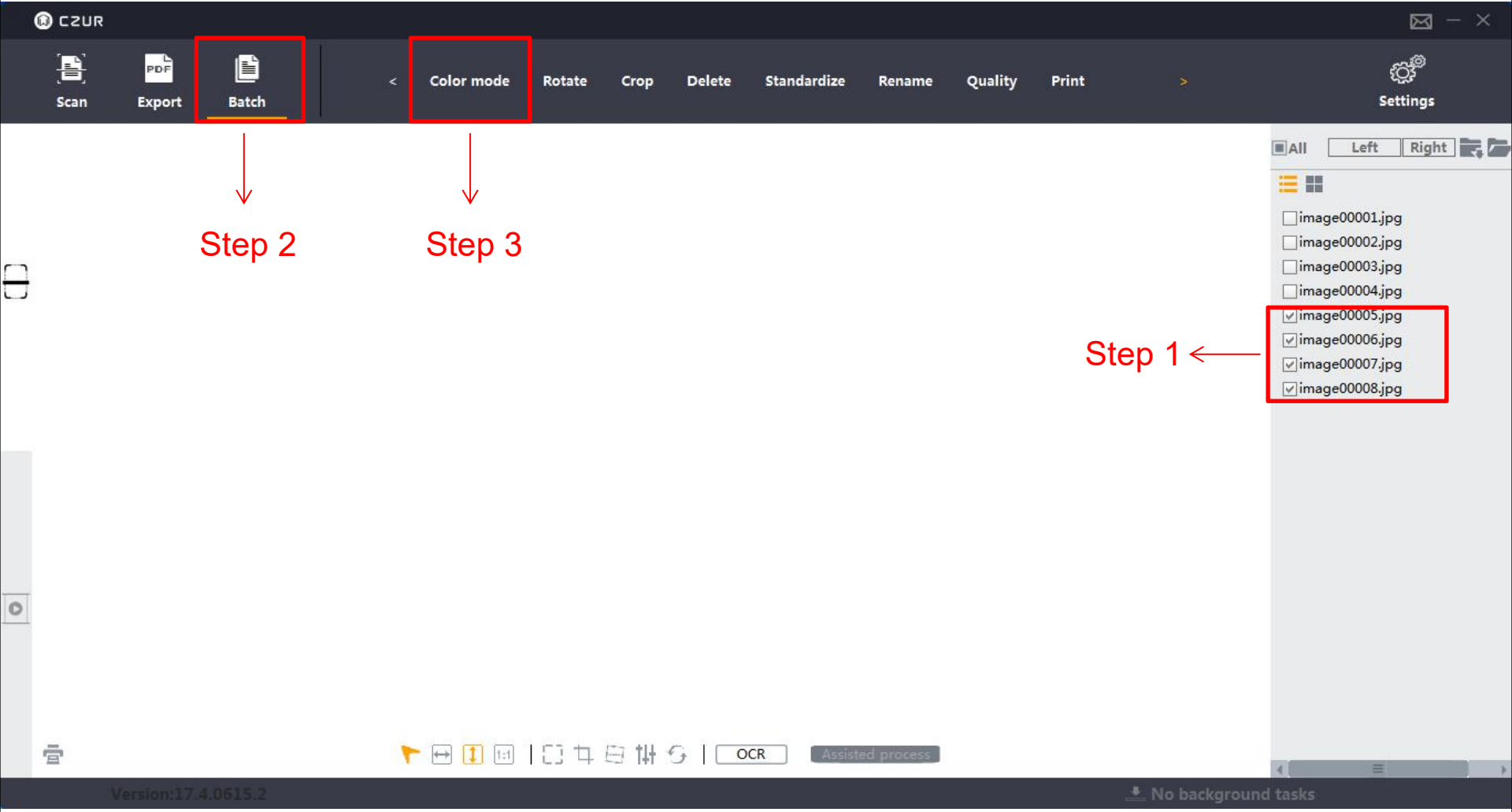
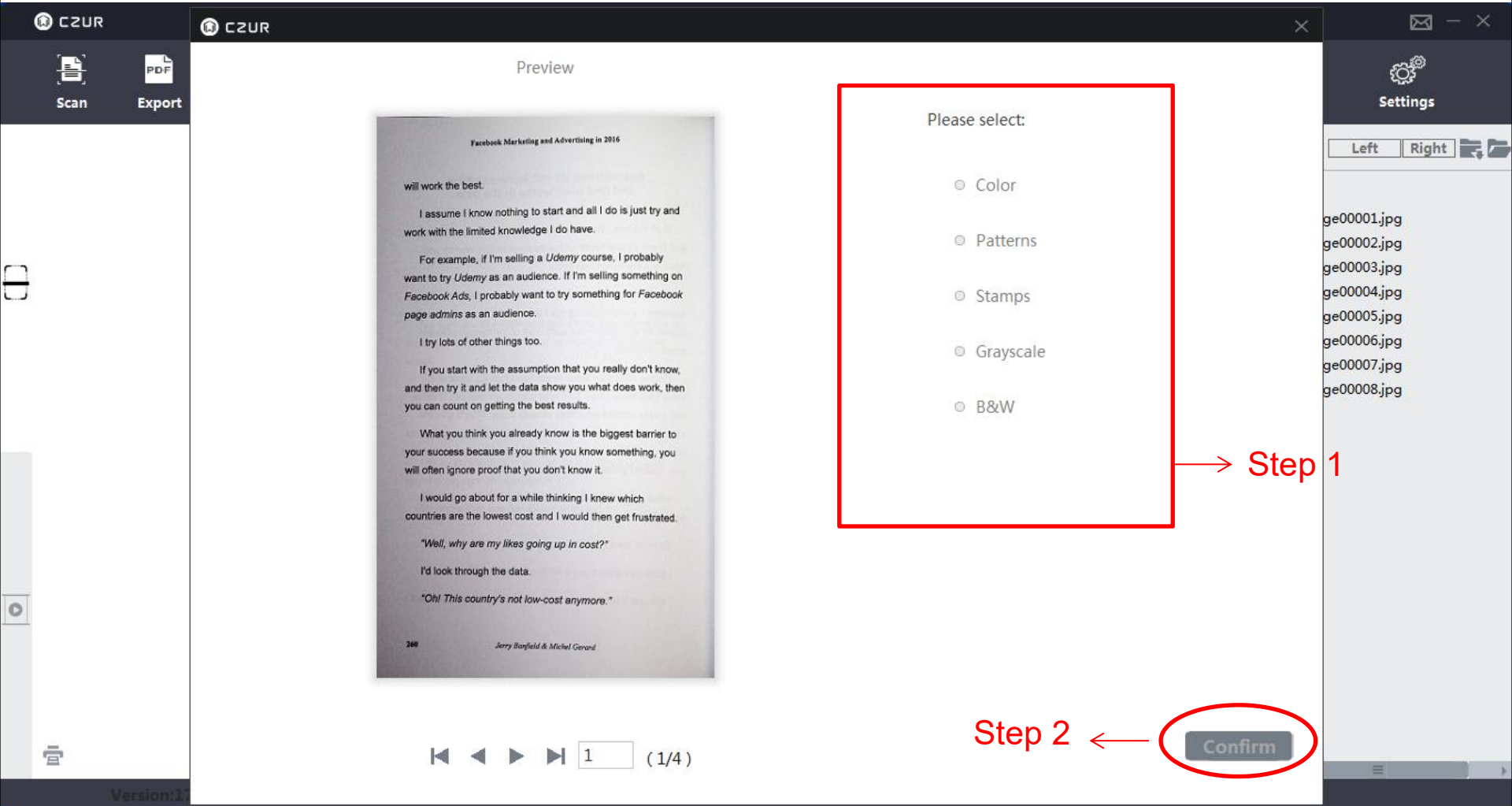


How to use color mode
