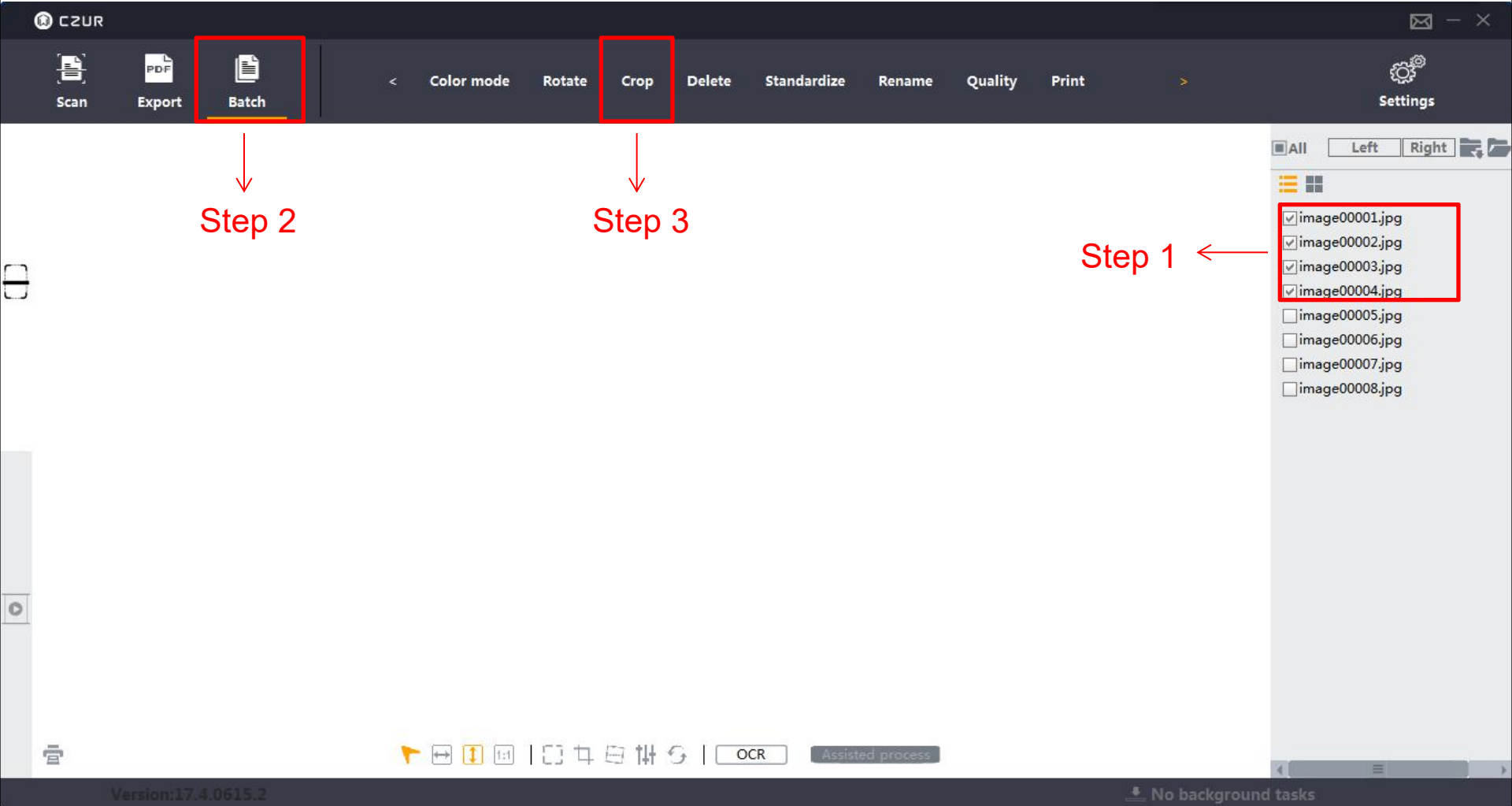


# How to use Crop
